

Stormwater Management

- Stormwater runoff contains debris, chemicals, dirt and other pollutants that need to be filtered prior to the runoff discharging into nearby lakes and streams.
- Stormwater Management (SWM)
 features are landscaping elements
 that help to purify the runoff from
 pavements, but are also aesthetically
 pleasing.
- Some of the SWM techniques being considered for the project are illustrated in the photos on the right.
- Proposed locations and design approaches are under design.
